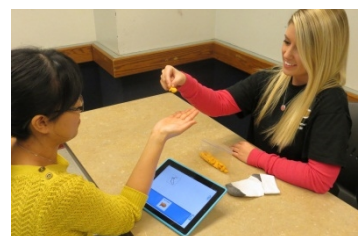
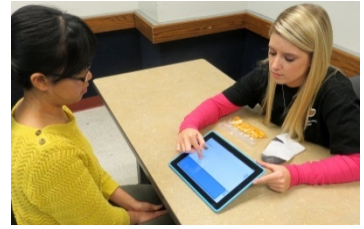


Error Correction Cheat Sheet

4-Step Error Correction:

1. Return the distracter symbol on the iPad.
2. Pair the preferred item with the graphic symbol and provide a model for the child by tapping or pointing to the correct symbol. Entice the child again with the two items.
3. Once the child selects the correct symbol, give praise but do not give the actual item to the child.
4. Redirect the child by asking him or her to tap his or her nose or head. Start over again by re-presenting the distracter and the preferred item. Say "let's do it again."
5. Now the child should select the correct graphic symbol. Give praise and provide the preferred item once this is done.
6. If the child still does not select the correct graphic symbol, repeat the error correction over again.
7. The trial is finished once the child independently selects the correct graphic symbol.



Backwards Chaining:

1. Return both graphic symbols to the display area.



2. Provide prompting as needed for the child to start over in the correct order.

⇒ Point to the “I want” symbol.



⇒ If the child does not respond, physically prompt the child by guiding his or her hand to move the graphic symbols to the sentence strip.



3. Fade out prompting. In the next trial, the child should respond to pointing. If not, resume physical prompting.
